Key Stage 2 Attainment

- The percentage of disadvantaged pupils attaining at the expected level or above in reading was 64% which was broadly in line with the national average
- The percentage of disadvantaged pupils attaining at the expected level or above in writing was 62% which was broadly in line with the national average
- The percentage of disadvantaged pupils attaining at the expected level or above in GPS was 71% which was broadly in line with the national average
- The percentage of disadvantaged pupils attaining at the expected level or above in maths was 71% which was 1% above the national average
- The percentage of disadvantaged pupils attaining at the expected level or above combined was 64% which was 11% above the national average

Key Stage 1 Attainment

- The percentage of disadvantaged pupils attaining at the expected level or above in reading was 82% which was broadly in line with the national average
- The percentage of disadvantaged pupils attaining at the expected level or above in writing was 71% which was broadly in line with the national average
- The percentage of disadvantaged pupils attaining at the expected level or above in maths was 71% which was broadly in line with the national average

Year 1 Phonics attainment

- disadvantaged pupils achieved 84% which was 3% above the national average

EYFS

- The percentage of pupils with entitlement to FSM achieving a good level of development was above the national average at 71% compared with 52% nationally
