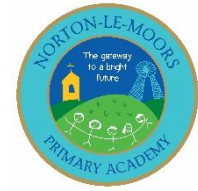


PUPIL PREMIUM IMPACT

The impact of this funding last year (2017/2018) Norton Le Moors



Key Stage 2 Attainment

- The percentage of disadvantaged pupils attaining at the expected level or above in reading was 64% which was broadly in line with the national average
- The percentage of disadvantaged pupils attaining at the expected level or above in writing was 62% which was broadly in line with the national average
- The percentage of disadvantaged pupils attaining at the expected level or above in GPS was 71% which was broadly in line with the national average
- The percentage of disadvantaged pupils attaining at the expected level or above in maths was 71% which was in line with the national average
- The percentage of disadvantaged pupils attaining at the expected level or above combined was 64% which was 11% above the national average

Key Stage 1 Attainment

- The percentage of disadvantaged pupils attaining at the expected level or above in reading was 79% which was broadly in line with the national average
- The percentage of disadvantaged pupils attaining at the expected level or above in writing was 93% which was well above the national average
- The percentage of disadvantaged pupils attaining at the expected level or above in maths was 93% which was well above the national average

Year 1 Phonics Attainment

- disadvantaged pupils achieved 86% which was 5% above the national average

EYFS Attainment

- The percentage of pupils with entitlement to FSM achieving a good level of development was above the national average at 80% compared with 52% nationally
